<u>Judo Saskatchewan Selection/Funding Criteria for Team Travel</u>

Basic Criteria

Athletes wishing to travel with the Judo Saskatchewan Provincial Team and wish to receive funding must meet certain basic criteria as follows:

- Must be registered with Judo Saskatchewan
- Must train a minimum of three times per week (judo plus strength & conditioning)
- Must participate in weekly High Performance Regional Trainings unless distance prohibits this
- Must attend fall, winter and summer camps.
- Must attend provincial competitions
- Must attend provincial trainings after each tournament
- Must have a good judo relationship with their club coach and with provincial coaches.
- Must sign an Athlete Code of Conduct (along with parent signature if athlete is under the age of 18)
- Must be committed to the Judo Saskatchewan High Performance Plan and the performance pathway.

Note: If an individual cannot make an event they must notify the Provincial Coach prior to the event.

Points GridOnce the basic criteria are met competition points will be awarded as follows.

Once the basic criteria are met participation points will be awarded as follows.

Note: In order to qualify for points an individual must have demonstrated the ability to win medals in province and win matches out of province.

Qualifying Period

The qualifying period to earn points shall be one calendar year prior to the event being selected for

Selections

All Selections will be made by the Selections Committee.

Funding

The budget will determine the amount of funding available to be provided. Based on the funds available:

Tier 1 Athletes - will have 75% of the per athlete costs provided

Tier 2 Athletes – will have 50% of the per athlete cost provided

<u>Tier 3 Athletes</u> will not be provided funding and must pay the full per athlete cost.

Appeals Process

A club or an individual may question the decision of the Selection Committee directly to the Selection Committee. If they are still not satisfied they may appeal in writing to the Vice-President who shall investigate and make a ruling. An appeal of the Vice President's ruling shall be in writing and taken it to the members of the Executive for final decision.

Canada Winter Games

In preparing for the 2023 Canada Winter Games, extra consideration may be given to Canada Winter Games age athletes.
