<u>Judo Saskatchewan Selection/Funding Criteria for Team Travel</u>

Basic Criteria

Athletes wishing to travel with the Judo Saskatchewan Provincial Team and wish to receive funding must meet certain basic criteria as follows:

- Must be registered with Judo Saskatchewan
- Must train a minimum of three times per week (judo plus strength & conditioning)
- Must participate in weekly High Performance Regional Trainings unless distance prohibits this
- Must attend provincial fall, winter and summer camps.
- Must attend provincial competitions
- Must attend provincial trainings after each tournament
- Must have a good judo relationship with their club coach and with provincial coaches.
- Must sign an Athlete Code of Conduct (along with parent signature if athlete is under the age of 18)
- Must be committed to the Judo Saskatchewan High Performance Plan and the performance pathway.

Note: If an individual cannot make an event they must notify the Provincial Coach prior to the event.

Points Grid

The result is calculated based on total points earned from results in their age group at the following events with a minimum of three entries and one win.

- If an athlete gets a minimum of two wins in a division of 16 or more athletes the athlete will receive 60% of the 5th place points
- If an athlete has no one in their division at a provincial event they will be granted first place points

- Athletes shall be awarded points for their best performance in a qualified division ie. bronze in U21 and gold in senior, the athlete would receive the 1st place points for that division
- U14 points may be used towards consideration for selection to events but will not be admissible towards funding on the national tour

Once the basic criteria are met participation points will be awarded as follows.

Following an approved Strength & Conditioning program	
Continue to train through the summer months.	
Interprovincial Camps	50
Judo Sask Summer Camp	50
Judo Sask Fall Camp	40
Judo Sask Winter Camp	40

Note: In order to qualify for points an individual must have demonstrated the ability to win medals in province and win matches out of province.

Qualifying Period

The qualifying period to earn points shall be one calendar year prior to the event being selected for.

Selections

All selections will be made by the Selection Committee. The first consideration will be athletes having met the basic criteria and the second consideration will be the athlete's placement on the points total. The Selection Committee has the right to consider other factors and may add or remove an athlete based on their performance, commitment and potential.

Funding

The budget will determine the amount of funding available to be provided to each athlete. The available funding will be distributed based on the points level achieved by each athlete. Athletes who are selected but no funding is available may be approved to attend and pay the full athlete cost.

Appeals Process

An appeal regarding team selection may be filed in accordance with the Judo Saskatchewan appeal process.
