## All Ages Ne-waza Judo Tournament and U10 U12 Tachi-waza Competition

**TOURNAMENT LOCATION:** 2400 - 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Regina SK (Regina downtown YMCA Dojos)

**Registration Time:** 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM for U8, U10, U12, 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM for U14 up to Seniors.

There will be no official weigh in. Competitors will be combined based on relative size and number of entries. Athletes wishing to move up into older divisions must have permission from their coaches and be approved by the tournament director.

**Referee Meeting:** 10:30 AM

**Competition Start Time:** 11:00 AM for U8-U12, 12:45 PM for U14-Seniors

**Order of competition:** U8, U10 and U12 ne-waza in both dojos, U10 and U12 Tachi-waza in big dojo. U14, U16, U18, U21 and Seniors big dojo after tachi-waza.

The small dojo will be used as a warm up area after the U10 and U12 divisions are done.

**Registration fees:** \$10.00 for all Ne-waza, \$10.00 for U10 and U12 Tachi-waza.

**\*\*\*\*\*Draw Format\*\*\*\*\*:**

- For **U8** divisions, these will be exhibition matches to allow coaches and competitors to be on the mat at the same time to learn the ne-waza tournament system. These matches will be 1 minute and 30 seconds in length straight time with no scoring. All competitors will receive a medal.
- For **U10, U12** divisions, Draws will be made for the divisions based on entries. A round robin pool system will be used where each entrant will compete against the other pool members. Smaller pools may do a double round robin to get each competitor more matches. These matches will be 2 minutes in length straight time with no scoring. All competitors will receive a medal.
- For **U14 to Senior** divisions, Draws will be made for the divisions based on entries. A round robin pool system will be used where each entrant will compete against the other pool members. Smaller pools may do a double round robin to get each competitor more matches but each win counts towards the final placing. These matches will be 3 minutes stop time and unlimited golden score if required.
- For divisions with eight (8) or more entrants it will be a true double elimination system.
- For divisions with six (6) or seven (7) there will be two pools of round robin. The winner of Pool A (A1) will meet the second place from pool B (B2) and the winner of Pool B (B1) will meet the second place from pool A (A2). The winners of this match will then meet to determine 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> while the losers will meet for bronze.
- For divisions of five (5), four (4) or three (3) entrants there will be a pool system where each entrant meets all entrants in a round robin format. The competitor with the most wins will get 1<sup>st</sup> and so on. In the event of a tie, a tie breaker will be done to determine those placings.
- For weight categories of two entrants they will meet twice or until one entrant has two (2) wins.

**Tournament Guidelines:**

- **Judo Saskatchewan and Judo Canada** scoring and rules to be used.
- Members must be in good standing with Judo Saskatchewan.
- The competition is open to all belt ranks.
- There will be no shime waza or kansetsu waza for any match where one or both competitors are under green belt or in age divisions where shine waza or kansetsu waza are not allowed.
- The tournament committee reserves the right to make any changes necessary in the best interest of the athletes.
- Age and divisions may be combined if unsuitable numbers of athletes are registered in a particular division.
- Females must wear a plain white shirt under their judogi.
