Beginners Judo Tournament Guidelines

U8** will do more of a judo festival style

- U8 must be born 2012 or later
- They will all come on to one mat at a time
- they will do backwards breakfalls, forward shoulder breakfalls
- they will partner up and do ne-waza randori
- no formal judging will occur
- club coaches can come on the mat to assist their athletes
- U8 will only do Ne-waza

U10 >U12

- Ne-waza -must be white, white/yellow, yellow, yellow/orange belts
- Regular Shiai- must be yellow, yellow/orange, orange belt

Note: U10-U12 yellow, yellow/orange can do both ne-waza & Shiai portions

Draw Format:

- For U10>U12 a round robin pool system will be used where each entrant meets each other entrant only once. Attempts will be made to have 4 person divisions. There will be no fight-off outside the pool.
- For weight categories of two entrants they will meet twice or until one entrant has two (2) wins.

Tournament Guidelines:

- **Modified** IJF rules to be used.
- Members must be in good standing with Judo Saskatchewan.
- White belts and half white half yellow belts may participate in newaza only.
- Yellow belts and half yellow half orange belts may participate in newaza and/or regular shiai.
- Orange belts may participate in regular shiai only
- The tournament committee in its sole discretion reserves the right to make any changes necessary in the best interest of the athletes.
- Weight classes may be combined if unsuitable numbers of athletes are registered in a particular weight division.
- U10 & U12 ages **may** be combined for newaza.
- Females must wear a plain white t-shirt under their judogi.

Note: No shime waza (including sankaku gatame) or kansetu waza for any competitors at this event.

- **U10** The grip is allowed only at the front of the judogi.
The following actions and waza are forbidden:
 - Head locking with a grip over or around the neck
 - All drop down techniques, which start on one or both knees
 - Tani otoshi
 - Makikomi waza
 - Sutemi waza
- **U12** The grip allowed only at the front of the judogi.
The following actions and waza are forbidden.

- Head locking with a grip over or around the neck
- All drop down techniques, which start on one or both knees
- Tani otoshi
- Makikomi waza
- Sutemi waza
